POST OPERATIVE CARE PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Leave gauze in place at least one hour. Change gauze every 1/2 hour thereafter until bleeding has stopped.
- 2. Do not rinse your mouth until tomorrow. Rinsing may dislodge the blood clot and interrupt the normal healing process. Try to avoid smoking, hot and spicy foods as well.
- 3. Maintain a soft diet. Do not chew on the side of the extraction. Drink plenty of fluids but do not drink through a straw.
- 4. If abnormal bleeding occurs, moisten a plain teabag and place it over the area of surgery and bite on it for twenty minutes.
- 5. Good oral hygiene with regular brushing should be maintained, except the area of surgery.
- Take advil or Aleve if neccessary for discomfort and inflamation.
